  A 15 ins. Douglas Fir bears S 5"W, 15.80 ft. dist., well healed face.

  A steel T post bears North, 1.30 ft. dist., with sign WC.

  Corner bears SE, 3.0 ft. dist. from edge of cliff.
- Cleared brush and exposed and painted the concrete portion of monument. Painted red bands around the bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.




