1/4 Corner between Sections 32 and 33 Twp. 36 N., R. 28 W., M.P.M.

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Original record 1903 - Corner description
A limestone 14"x 9" x 5" - 9" in ground mkd. 1/4 on W. face from which
A 32" fir on line 32 lks North mkd. two notches on N. and S.
A 12" fir bears S 44 1/2 E 55 lks. mkd 1/4 S 33 BT
A 30" pine bears S 30 W 27 lks. mkd. 1/4 S 32 BT
AUGUST 1966 -- Exhaustive search -- failed to find original stone
Point falls on small flat bench about 8' E.&W. and 20' N.&S. between two
small cliffs about 8' high. The 32" fir reported on line 32 lks. north of
the corner is live but dying (The top is dead) Two notches on north and
south plain and unmistakeable. The SE BT reported a 12" fir is now 26" in
dia. We chopped out the blaze - marked as reported. We tagged with standard
BT sign. SW BT as reported was evidently an error no evidence of such a
tree but remains of large fir NW of corner - possibly original BT.

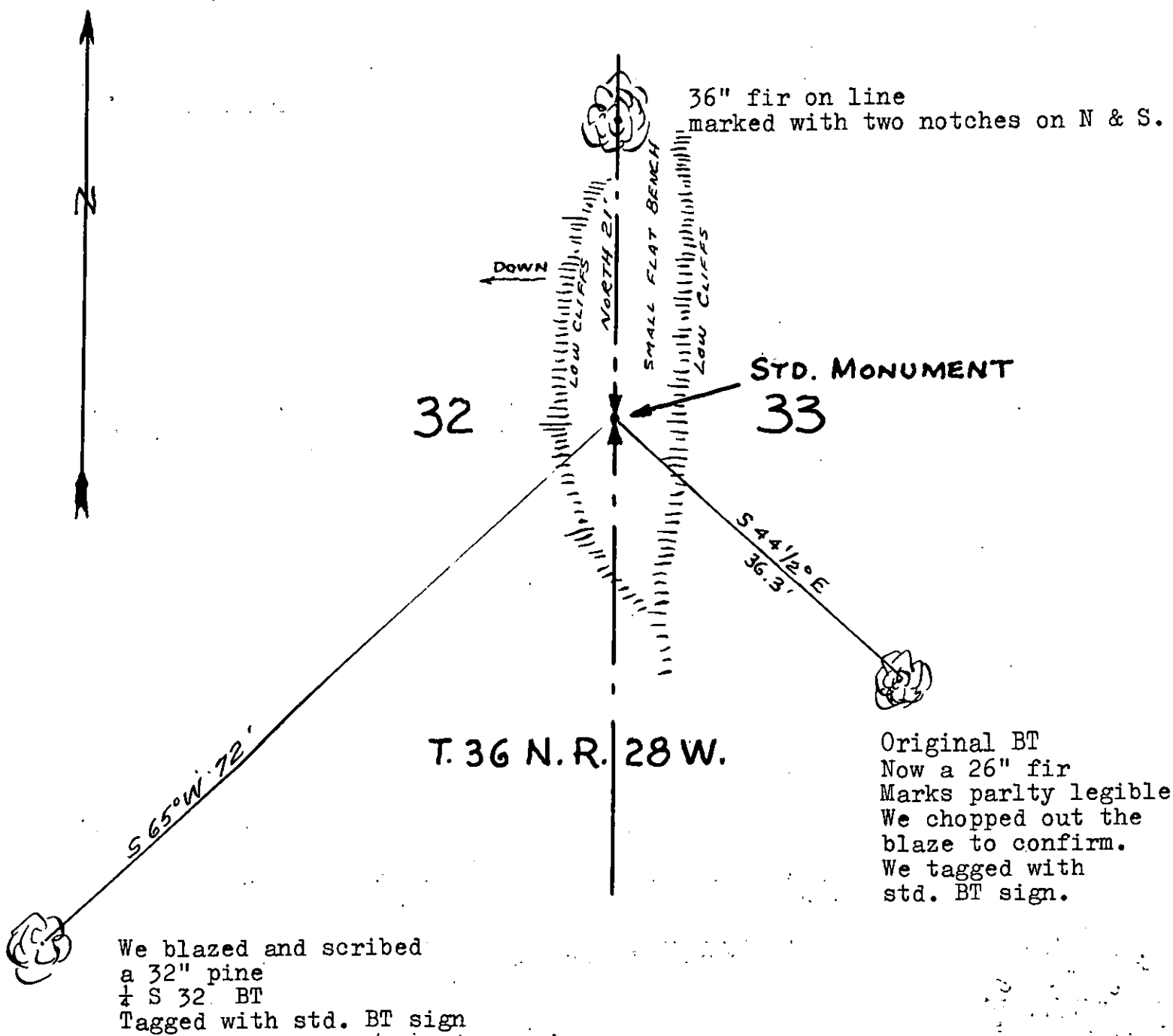
