
CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

Corner C 1/4 Sec. 32 T. 37N R. 27W P.M., MT Lincoln County

- I. <u>1978 Certificate of Survey No. 541 by D.K. Marquardt, Registration No. 2989 ES:</u> Set a 5/8 in. x 24 in. rebar, with plastic cap, stamped "2989 ES".
- II. Found a 5/8 in. diam. rebar, firmly set, protruding 2 ins. above the ground, with a plastic cap mkd. "Marquardt 2989 ES". No bearing trees found.
- III. At the corner point, as determined by the found rebar, set an aluminum rod, 30 ins. long, 3/4 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with a 3 1/4 in. diam. aluminum cap, mkd. as shown.




Established two bearing trees:

A pine, 17 ins. diam., bears S22°W, 49.6 ft. dist., mkd. "C 1/4 S32 BT". A pine, 13 ins. diam., bears S78°W, 42.5 ft. dist., mkd. "C 1/4 S32 BT".

Drove the found rebar flush with the ground, alongside the set pipe. Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs. A 6 in. x 8 in. x 5 ft., out of ground treated fence post, bears E., 0.7 ft. dist., to the center of the post, with a Land Survey Monument sign attached.

Magnetic Declination: 20° East.
