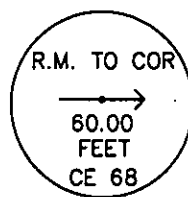

I. Record: 1894 original GLO Subdivisions and Meanders of Fractional Township 37 North, Range 28 West by Frank L. Sizer & Abram L. Jaqueth: 80.00 chains. Set a granite stone 14"x 10" x 5", 10" in the ground for cor. to secs. 13, 14, 23 & 24, marked with 3 notches on S. & 1 notch on E. edges from which:

- A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N54°E, 155 lks. dist., marked T37N R28W S13 BT.
- A yellow pine, 18 ins. diam., bears S50 1/4°E, 53 lks. dist., marked T37N R28W S24 BT.
- A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S61 1/4°W, 48 lks., marked T37N R28W S23 BT.
- A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N5 1/2°W, 163 lks., marked T37N R28W S14 BT.

1969 Certified Corner Recordation, Book 1, Page 145, by Lawrence A. Signani, Washington Reg. No. 11422:

Found: BT that bears N54°E, 155 lks., mkd. T37N R28W S13 BT.  
Set 80 penny nail in road at a dist. of 155 lks. & bearing of S54°W from recovered BT.  
Set a brass cap 60.00' due west of corner. Brass cap stamped:  
Scribed 15" fir bears N64°W, 35', mkd. FS/RM.

Found root wad of 14 ins. fir bears S.61 1/4°W., 31.7 ft.  
Found 15 ins. fir bears N.64°W. 35 ft., mkd. FS/RM.

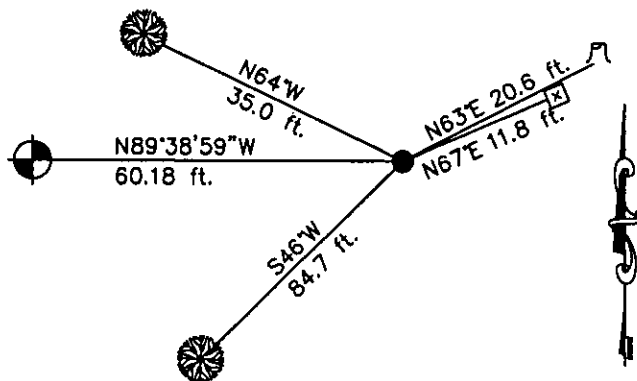

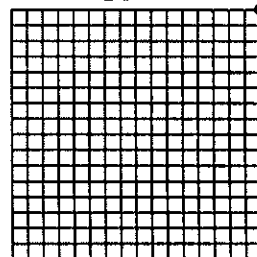

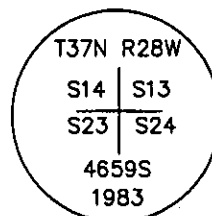

1995 U.S.F.S. Certificate of Survey No. 2317 by Ronald A. Pearson, Reg. No. 9008LS: Fd. a 5/8" alum. rod with 3 1/4" U.S.F.S. aluminum cap, marked by Carl R. McMillen, Reg. No. 4659S in 1983, buried in road surface.

1998 Certificate of Survey No. 2510 by Dawn Marquardt, Reg. No. 7328S: True Section Corner, Fd D.P.A. Cap

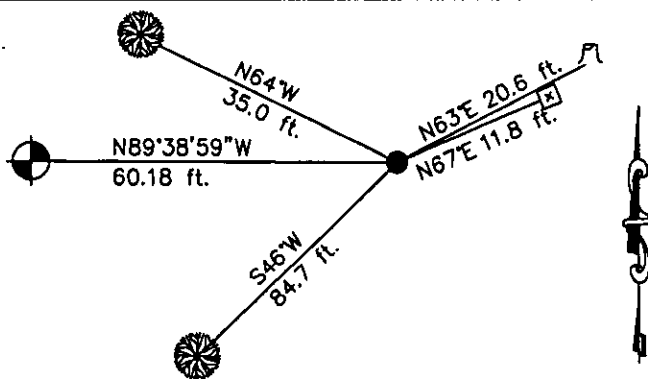

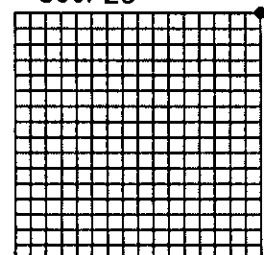
