
 1. 1989 Certified Corner Recordation by MT Reg. No. 2734S: Set a standard 3 1/4 inch Forest Service alum. cap on a 5/8 inch rod 25 inches into the ground;

from which:

An 8 inch fir bears S63°E, 33.60 feet, scribed E 1/16 S2 CC BT. A 10 inch pine bears S13°E, 59.72 feet scribed E 1/16 S2 CC BT. Set a USDA steel post 25 feet south of corner.

- Found a 3 1/4 inch USDA aluminum monument, 6 ins. out of ground.
 Steel post with LSM and Boundary decals 25 ft. south of monument.
 An 11 inch douglas fir S63°E, 33.60 ft., with a well healed face.
 A 12 inch ponderosa pine S13°E, 59.72 ft., with open face E1/16 S2 CC BT visible.
- 3. Stacked and painted small mound of stone around monument. Put aluminum nails at record distances. Repainted rings and blazes on BTs. Put new BT tag and LSM signs on Ponderosa pine BT.
