1. Original and/or subsequent record used to evaluate the corner position.
2. Description of evidence, note discrepancies in the record, state method of establishing or obliterated corners.
3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
4. Sketch or corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

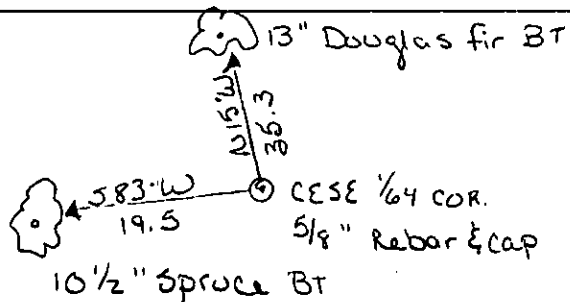
I. 1991 Davis Surveying, Inc.

I set a 5/8" inch dia. x 24 inch long rebar with yellow PVC cap stamped KED 4975 S from which;

A Douglas fir, 13 inches DBH, bears N15° W 35.3 feet from center of tree, scribed CESE 1/16 S9 BT

A Spruce, 10 1/2 inches DBH, bears S 83° W 19.5 feet from the center of the tree, scribed CESE 1/16 S9 BT

Painted a 6 inch wide red band around BTs with BT signs on front and warning signs #54.9 on back.
