CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION


Corner 4 HES 833 Sec. 23 T. 37 N R. 31 W P.M., MT Lincoln County

I. 1919 U.S. Forest Service original record by W. P. Stephenson: Set a small stone, marked with a cross (x), under an iron post, 2 ins. daim., 36 ins. long, 24 ins. in the ground with a brass cap marked 1919 4 H E S 833, and a point on top for the exact corner point, from which:

A cross (x) on a fir tree, 5 ins. diam., bears N38° 03'W, 19 lks. dist. A cross (x) on a pine tree, 6 ins. diam., bears N 64° 42'E, 28 lks. dist., each blazed and scribed 4 H E S 833 BT.

Raised a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, NW of corner.

II. Found a 2 1/2 in. daim. iron pipe, firmly set, 11 ins. above the ground, with a USFS brass cap mkd. as shown.



from which:

A down pine stump, 7 ins. diam., bears N 65°E, 18.5 ft. dist., mkd. with visible scribe marks.

A rotten fir stump, bears N 38°W, 12.3 ft. dist., mkd. with visible scribe marks.

III. Established two new bearing trees:

A larch, 30 ins. diam., bears S 71°W, 41.0 ft. dist., mkd. 4 HES 833 BT. A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears S 14°W, 47.3 ft. dist., mkd. 4 HES 833 BT.

Painted bearing trees and attached Land Survey Monument and Bearing Tree signs.
