I. 1915 U.S. Forest Service original record by Fred E. Thieme: Set a small stone, marked with a cross (x), under a quartzite stone, 25x9x8 ins., 15 ins. in the ground, marked "5 H.E.S. 502" on E. face, and a cross (x) on top for the exact corner point.

from which:

A cross (x) on a lodgepole pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S 64° 42'W, 10 lks. dist. A cross (x) on a lodgepole pine, 11 ins. diam., bears N 37° 06'W, 24 lks. dist. Each blazed and scribed "5 H.E.S. 502 BT'

Raised a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high, East of corner.

II. Found stone, firmly set, 6 x 7 ins., 9 ins. above ground, mkd. "5 H.E.S. 502" on E. face, with a cross (x) on top;

from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A down pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S 46°E, 25.0 ft. (38 lks.) dist., with visible scribing. (No record)

A down pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S 64°W, 6.6 ft. (10 lks.) dist., with visible scribing.

A down pine, 11 ins. diam., bears N 37°W, 15.8 ft. (24 lks.) dist., with visible scribing.

A concrete pier, 6 ins. diam., with an inset brass tablet, 3 ins. diam, bears East, 1.0 ft. dist., mkd. "JED". (No record)

III. Established 2 new bearing trees:

A spruce, 10 ins. diam., bears S 22°E, 14.4 ft. dist., mkd. "5 HES 502 BT". A spruce, 13 ins. diam., bears N 80°W, 14.5 ft. dist., mkd. "5 HES 502 BT".
