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From which, established new accessories (Montana accessories only):

A Subalpine Fir, 9 ins. in diam., bears N. 57° E., a distance of 24.3 ft., scribed MONTANA BT in a double blaze and M 0 (for Mile Zero) scribed in the snow blaze.

A stainless steel post, 36 ins. long, 2 ½ ins. in diam., for a reference monument, bears S. 34°30' E., a distance of 11.64 ft., with two magnetic memorials set along the East & West sides of the post, 12 ins. below the ground surface; at the base of the post, set a bottle of Crown Royal whisky (with about 3 oz. remaining), also at the base, placed a plastic bottle of Dr. Pepper, containing: a penny, two nickels, a dime, a quarter, numerous business cards from crew members present, a page of "Rite-In-The-Rain" paper with all crew members names written on it, and a red plastic survey cap marked "Block 7918S"; the post has a 3 ¼ ins. diam. brass cap marked:

From which, new accessories:

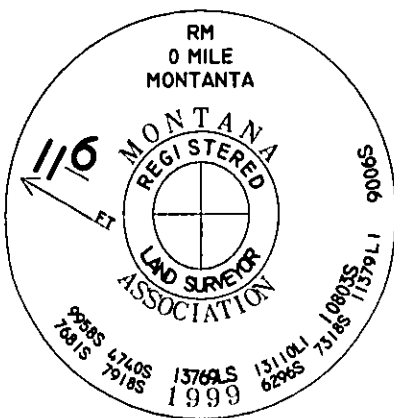
A Western Red Cedar, 8 ins. in diam., bears S. 6° E., a distance of 29.8 ft., scribed MONTANA BT, in a single blaze, with a snow blaze above.

Refer to a Corner Perpetuation and Filing Record form recorded in Boundary County, Idaho, by Frank S. Wratni, R.L.S. 4343, for the Idaho Professional Land Surveyors Society, in unsurveyed Section 10, Township 65 North, Range 3 East, Boise Meridian.

A location poster was set North, 142.5 ft. distance. The International Boundary is North, 167 ft. distance from the granite monument.

Geographic Position: Lat. 49° 00' 01.6" North, Long. 116° 02' 52.9" West, NAD-27, ±5 meters, using a Trimble Pathfinder GPS receiver.

Painted bearing trees and attached Bearing Tree signs. Field work done on August 8, 1999.



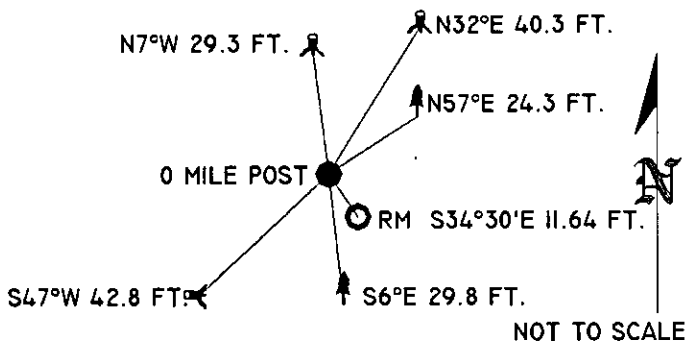
Magnetic Declination: 20° East assumed. Equipment used: staff compass and Kesson tape.
