## RESOLUTION 2023-29

### RESOLUTION TO AMEND FISHER RIVER VALLEY FIRE SERVICE AREA FEE SCHEDULE

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR LINCOLN COUNTY,  
MONTANA FINDS:

1. The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners created the Fisher River Valley Fire Service Area under the provision of MCA 7-33-2401.
2. On August 17, 2023, the Lincoln County Board of Commissioners received a request from the Board of Trustees of the Fisher River Valley Fire Service Area to amend the fee schedule as follows:

CLASSIFICATION	PRESENT FEE	PROPOSED FEE
Class 1 Residential Properties	\$140 / year	\$200 / year
Class 2 Commercial, standard	\$280 / year	\$340 / year
Class 3 Commercial selling fuel	\$350 / year	\$410 / year
MOB (Structural Improvements)	\$140 / year	\$200 / year

3. The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners passed Resolution 2023-23 dated August 23, 2023. A Resolution of Intent to Amend the Fisher River Valley Fire Service Area Fee Schedule.
4. A Public Notice was issued pursuant to MCA 7-1-2121.
5. A Public Hearing was held September 28, 2023, at 6:00 PM at the Fire Station at 70 West Camp Road Libby, MT 59923 for the purpose of public comment for or against the fee schedule amendment as set forth above.
6. The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners has considered all comments and has concluded that the amendment to the fee schedule of the Fisher River Valley Fire Service Area should be adopted as set forth above.

## THE BOARD RESOLVES:

1. The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners hereby adopts the fee schedule to be charged to owners of structures within the Fisher River Valley Fire Service Area pursuant to MCA 7-33-2404 as set forth above.

## THE BOARD FURTHER RESOLVES:

If a provision of this resolution conflicts with a provision of a previously adopted resolution, this resolution will prevail.

1. This resolution and its various sections, clauses and paragraphs are severable. If any part, sentence, clause, or phrase is adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of the resolution will not be affected.
2. This resolution will be effective immediately upon adoption, in accordance with § 7-5-123, MCA.
3. This Board directs that this resolution be entered into the minutes and signed by the Chair of the Board in accordance with § 7-5-121, MCA.


