The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners met for a regular session on January 26, 2022 in the Lincoln County Courthouse, Libby, Montana. Present were Commissioner Bennett, Commissioner Letcher, Commissioner Teske and Deputy Clerk and Recorder Corrina Brown. County Administrator Jim Hammons was excused.

Meeting allows for teleconferencing and VisionNet availability.

Commissioner Bennett opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and Prayer.

10:30 AM Administrative Issues: Present were Derrick Perkins, DC Orr, Tom Lane, Ray Stout, Solomon Alcain and Sheldon Letcher.

- Corrina submitted the minutes for January 19, 2022 regular meeting for approval. **Motion** by Commissioner Teske to approve minutes as submitted. Second by Commissioner Letcher, motion carried unanimously.
- Commissioner Bennett advised that Jim Hammons is working on a letter of support for the ASA Wood Remediation School Grant.
- Commissioner Bennett advised Angel Island is seeking to expand their water storage and are requesting a letter of support for a Resource Planning Grant. Motion by Commissioner Teske to write a letter of support for Angel Island's Resource Planning Grant. Second by Commissioner Letcher, motion carried unanimously.

10:45 AM Public Comment Time: Present were Derrick Perkins, DC Orr, Tom Lane, Ray Stout, Solomon Alcain and Sheldon Letcher.

Sheldon Letcher commented that more wolf hunting and more logging should be done as they enhance one another as well as providing better habitat. Commissioner Teske concurred that is very popular.

DC Orr thanked Commissioner Teske for aid in getting his complaints filed. DC stated he has two case numbers and is trying to get the county attorney's office to accept them. DC stated he filed an administrative complaint against Captain Boyd White. DC is looking for a written reply from County Commissioners regarding attaining their help. DC has received a deadline of Feb 5th for evidence to be destroyed from the County Attorney and is now seeking aid in getting a written opinion from the County Attorney. DC reiterated he has not retained an attorney. DC is not aware of what the landfill has that will be destroyed. Commissioner Bennett advised DC the Commissioners attempt to operate by Montana Code and he will be attending a meeting tomorrow to understand this better. DC thanked the commissioners for their time and thanked Sheldon for his input.
