The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners convened on January 29, 2024, in the Lincoln County Courthouse, 512 California Ave. Libby, Montana to discuss Montana's 6th local government review election question of establishing a study commission.

11:00 AM Present were Commissioner Letcher (via zoom), Commissioner Teske, Commissioner Hammons, Jennifer Brown, Corrina Brown, Jennifer Nelson, Melanie Howell and Sierra Gustin.

Dan Clark of Montana State University Extension Local Government Center, via Zoom, presented information on the history of local government review in the Montana Constitution, allowing voters to trigger a review of the process and structure of local government every ten years. He provided an overview of the process, statutes, and timelines.

Dan advised to pass a resolution calling for an election on the question of conducting a local government review and establishing a study commission to do so by the deadline of March 11, 2024. There was a discussion on the number of study commission members, funding, and the selection of an ex-officio, non-voting member to help direct the proceedings.
