

BASIS OF BEARING AND VARIATION

The basis of bearing for this survey is true north based on a static GNSS observation. Angular variation between this survey and COS 1363 is 00'01'54" between the C1/4 corner and the E1/4 corner of Section 4, T.29N., R.31W., as shown hereon.

METHOD OF SURVEY

A Trimble R10 Model 2 GNSS System was used to tie previously set controlling corners and decommissioned railroad alignment by Byron Sanderson, October,



VICINITY MAP: NE1/4 SECTION 4




CERTIFICATE OF SURVEY No. 5031

SURVEYORS NOTES:

 BOOK 45, PAGE 562, LINCOLN COUNTY RECORDS, FILED NOVEMBER 23, 1920, DEEDED A PORTION OF THE S1/2 NE1/4, SECTION 4, FROM FRANK AND LURA WEGNER TO THE LUKENS-HAZEL MINING COMPANY. AT THAT TIME, WEGNER OWNED ALL OF THE NE1/4 OF SECTION 4. THIS DEED DESCRIBES THE SUBJECT TRACT AS "ALL THAT LAND LYING ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF A LINE THIRTY FEET NORTH OF J. NEILS LUMBER COMPANY RAILROAD, SAID LINE IS TO RUN PARALLEL WITH THE SAID J. NEILS LUMBER COMPANY RAILROAD, AND TO BE THIRTY FEET NORTH OF THE CENTER OF SAID RAILROAD TRACK". THE DEED THEN REINFORCES THAT ALL LAND OWNED BY WEGNER LYING SOUTH OF THIS THIRTY FOOT OFFSET LINE, IS TO BE INCLUDED IN THE CONVEYANCE TO SAID MINING COMPANY. NO MAPS ARE RECORDED DEMONSTRATING THE LOCATION OF SAID RAILROAD. HOWEVER, A SITE INVESTIGATION IDENTIFIED AN OLD ROAD BED. WHICH WAS CONFIRMED TO BE THE RAILROAD GRADE DURING A DISCUSSION WITH MONTE WICKA, WHOSE FAMILY HAS OWNED THE ADJACENT NORTHERN PROPERTY SINCE 1959. ALTHOUGH THIS LINE WAS DECOMMISSIONED AND NO RAIL OR TIES REMAIN, MANY RAIL CLAMPS, RAILROAD SPIKES, AND MISC. PIECES OF IRON HARDWARE WERE FOUND ALONG THE COURSE. THE BED OF THE RAILROAD GRADE IS QUITE PREVALENT AND THE CENTERLINE SHOWN HEREON WAS TAKEN FROM THE APPARENT MID-POINT OF THIS DISCOVERED BED.

NO PHYSICAL OR LEGAL ACCESS TO THIS PROPERTY COULD BE DETERMINED VIA RECORDS RESEARCH.
