

Designation of Agent by an Individual with a Disability Application

A voter may apply to have another person designated as an agent for purposes such as providing a signature or identifying mark, delivering the voter's absentee ballot application, and assisting through the registration and voting process. The use of an agent is a reasonable accommodation under the provisions of 49-2-101(19)(b), MCA.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- A voter may rescind this agency at any time by notifying the election administrator.
- An agent must not be the voter's employer, an agent of the individual's employer, or an officer or agent of the voter's union.
- An election official must ask if the person being designated an agent is the voter's employer or employer's agent or
 officer or agent of the voter's union. If the proposed agent is one of those individuals, the voter must choose another
 person to be the voter's agent.
- An agent can be chosen only by the individual with a disability.
- If an agent, election administrator, or election judge signs or marks a document for a voter, the agent, election administrator, or election judge shall initial the signature or mark.
