The Lincoln County Local Government Review Study Commission is reaching out to the community to request input as part of the Local Government Review June 18th @ 5:30 p.m.

Background:

Every ten years, Montana residents have the constitutional right to initiate a Local Government Review. This process is unique to Montana and is intended to assess the effectiveness of each county's current system of governance.

Purpose of the Review:

The Lincoln County Study Commission is examining the county's:

Powers – What the county government is legally authorized to do

Form – Its organizational structure

Plan – Operational aspects such as terms of office, partisan vs. nonpartisan elections, etc.

We are also seeking community input on how well our government is meeting local needs and whether alternative structures or policies might better serve the public. If the Commission identifies areas for improvement, it may propose ballot measures to be decided by the voters.
