

LINCOLN COUNTY TAX APPEAL BOARD IN SESSION

In accordance with 15-15-101(6) MCA, the Lincoln County Tax Appeal Board will be extending the session from July 1st through **January 31st, 2026**, for the business of hearing appeals of property valuations set by the Montana Department of Revenue.

Any taxpayer who disagrees with the appraised value of his or her property may file an appeal with the Lincoln County Tax Appeal Board within 30 days of the date on the Notice of Classification and Appraisal or Notice to Change Valuation (assessment notice).

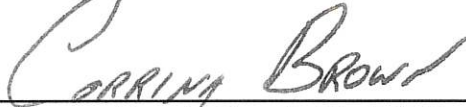
Appeal forms are available at the Lincoln County Clerk & Recorder's Office, or at the website of the Montana Tax Appeal Board, www.mtab.mt.gov.

Any appeal must be filed with the Office of the County Clerk and Recorder.

Upon receipt of the appeal, the County Tax Appeal Board Secretary will notify the appellant and schedule a County hearing.
