Please note the following updates regarding the Request for Proposal - Lincoln County Debris Removal and Disposal:

1. The due date for proposal submissions has been updated to: **February 3, 2026 at 5:00 PM**
2. The time and location of the proposal opening was updated to: **February 4, 2026 at 11:00 AM**. At the Lincoln County Courthouse at 512 California Ave, Libby, MT 59923. Zoom access will be available at the Eureka office for those who wish to attend from that location. Zoom link is located on the County Website.
3. An OPTIONAL pre-bid meeting will be held on **Monday, January 26, 2026 at 09:00 AM** at 512 California Ave, Libby, MT 59923. The meeting will consist of a Q&A followed by a site visit to see the vegetative debris at one of the sites.
4. Scope of Work section 1.6 was updated to: Debris collected must fall within the guidelines of the FEMA PA Guide FP-104-009-2 Public Assistance Program and Policy Guide Version 5. Any eligible debris, such as fallen trees, which extend onto the public ROW from private property, shall be cut at the point where it enters the ROW. Only that part of the debris that lies within the ROW shall be removed.
5. Scope of Work section 1.7 was updated to: Hazardous limbs are considered eligible debris and are defined as broken limbs or branches that pose an immediate threat.
 - 1.7.1. For example, a broken limb or branch hanging over improved property or public-use areas, such as trails, sidewalks, or playgrounds, poses an immediate threat of falling and causing injury to the public or damage to improved property.
6. Scope of Work section 7.10 was updated to: The Contractor shall comply with the Davis-Bacon Act (40 U.S.C. 276a to 276a-7) as supplemented by

Department of Labor regulations (29 CFR part 5) insofar as it may apply to this contract. The majority of work under this contract is expected to be performed under the FEMA Public Assistance program. FP 104-009-2 Public Assistance Program and Policy Guide (PAPPG) V5 (January 5, 2025) states Davis Bacon Act does not apply to the FEMA Public Assistance Program.
