The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners met for a special session on February 9, 2026, in the Lincoln County Courthouse Libby, Montana. Present were Commissioner Teske, Commissioner Hammons, Administrative Assistant Nikki Fox and Clerk and Recorder Corrina Brown.

Zoom participation: Commissioner Duram, Ray Stout and Roland Jorgenson

10:00 AM **Resolution 2026-07-Authorize Running the Special Purpose District Election:** Present were none.

Commissioner Hammons read Resolution 2026-07 authorizing the Lincoln County Election Department to conduct the regularly scheduled Special Purpose District Election on May 5, 2026, as an all-mail election concurrent with the school election. The election pertains to the Libby Park District's request for approval of a property tax increase to fund management and maintenance of recreational facilities, trails and the aquatic facility constructed in 2025 near the Fishpond in Libby, Montana. **Motion** by Commissioner Duram. Second by Commissioner Hammons. It was discussed that the proposed mill levy would supersede the current levy, not increase it. The existing levy brings in about \$11,500 per year, and the proposed levy would replace it with an estimated annual amount of \$74,000 if approved. No public comment. Motion carried.
