Lincoln County Government Review Study Commission Releases Tentative Report and Announces Public Hearings

The Lincoln County Local Government Review Study Commission has released its tentative report outlining findings and recommendations regarding the form and plan of county government. The Commission invites all residents to review the report and participate in upcoming public hearings to provide input before the report is finalized.

The draft report reflects months of community engagement, research, and analysis. The Commission conducted interviews and gathered feedback through a countywide survey to better understand the strengths and challenges of the current form of government.

The Study Commission was elected to review the form, plan and powers of the county government and propose any changes deemed beneficial to county residents.

Following the public hearing, the Commission will review all feedback and make any necessary revisions before adopting a final report. The final recommendations will be placed before the voters for consideration.
