A Resolution of The Lincoln County Board of Commissioners Designating Polling Places and Drop Kiosk Locations

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR LINCOLN COUNTY, MONTANA FINDS:

WHEREAS, Per MCA 13-3-105, the Board of County Commissioners is authorized to designate polling places for each precinct within the county; and

WHEREAS, in determining appropriate polling place locations, the Lincoln County Commission has considered multiple factors including, but not limited to:

- Ballot security
- reduction of ballot transport requirements
- the number of registered electors within each precinct
- geographic distance between polling locations
- Accessibility / ADA Compliance
- availability of election judges and election staff; and

WHEREAS, the Lincoln County Election Department has determined that the polling place locations designated herein are sufficient in size, accessibility, and capacity to accommodate the voters assigned to each precinct; and

WHEREAS, Lincoln County provides secure ballot drop kiosks to allow electors to deposit absentee ballots prior to Election Day; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Montana Code Annotated §13-19-307, the office of the Election Administrator is designated as an official place of deposit for absentee ballots and shall remain open during election hours on Election Day; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that all actions relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting in compliance with applicable law, and that all deliberations of this Board and any committees that resulted in these actions were conducted in meetings open to the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. Lincoln County Designated **Polling Places** are:

- Eureka – High Road Youth Center, 1295 2nd Ave. E. – Precincts 1, 2, 3, 4, 15, 16
- Troy – Troy Activity Center, 380 N 4th Street – Precincts 5, 6, 7, 8, 14
- Libby – Memorial Center, 111 E. Lincoln Blvd. – Precincts 9, 10, 11, 12, 13

2. The following secure ballot drop **Kiosks** are established for the deposit of absentee ballots prior to Election Day:

- Libby – Lincoln County Sheriff's Office, 512 California Avenue, Libby
- Troy – Troy Police Department Lobby, 301 N 3rd Street, Troy
- Eureka – Eureka Dispatch, 855 HWY 93 N, Eureka

These ballot drop kiosks shall be available twenty-four (24) hours per day, seven (7) days per week until Election Day and shall be closed on Election Day.

3. **Official Place of Deposit:**

The Lincoln County Election Office is designated as an official place of deposit for absentee ballots pursuant to Montana Code Annotated §13-19-307.

- Lincoln County Election Office, 418 Mineral Avenue, Libby

The Election Office shall be available for ballot deposit during normal business hours and during official election hours on Election Day.

4. **Mail Ballot** Elections:

For elections conducted as mail ballot elections, ballots may be returned by mail or delivered to the Lincoln County Election Office or any designated place of deposit as permitted by Montana law.

Voters are encouraged to consult the Lincoln County Elections website or contact the Election Office for information regarding whether a particular election is conducted by mail ballot or whether they are voting absentee.

THE BOARD FURTHER RESOLVES:

1. If a provision of this resolution conflicts with a provision of a previously adopted resolution, this resolution will prevail.
2. This resolution and its various sections, clauses and paragraphs are severable. If any part, sentence, clause, or phrase is adjudged to be unconstitutional or invalid, the remainder of the resolution will not be affected.
3. This resolution will be effective immediately upon adoption, in accordance with § 7-5-123, MCA.
4. This Board directs that this resolution be entered into the minutes and signed by the Chair of the Board in accordance with § 7-5-121, MCA.
