PURPOSE OF SURVEY

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY IS THE RESURVEY AND SECTION SUBDIVISION OF RECORD PARCELS OF LAND IN SECTION 1 AND SECTION 2, T.30N., R.34W., P.M.M., AND TO DISTINGUISH, BY MARKING AND POSTING, THE PROPERTY BOUNDARIES BETWEEN NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM LANDS AND PRIVATE LANDS. NO DIVISION OF LAND IS HEREBY CREATED, THEREFORE THIS SURVEY IS EXEMPT FROM SUBDIVISION REVIEW.

GPS REAL TIME KINEMATIC (RTK) USING A TRIMBLE R-10 BASE AND TRIMBLE R-12I ROVER. DISTANCES SHOWN ARE GROUND. FOREST BOUNDARIES MARKED WITH SIGNED ALUMINUM OR STEEL POSTS AT APPROXIMATELY 150 FOOT INTERVALS. TREES BLAZED AND PAINTED WITH RED PAINT.

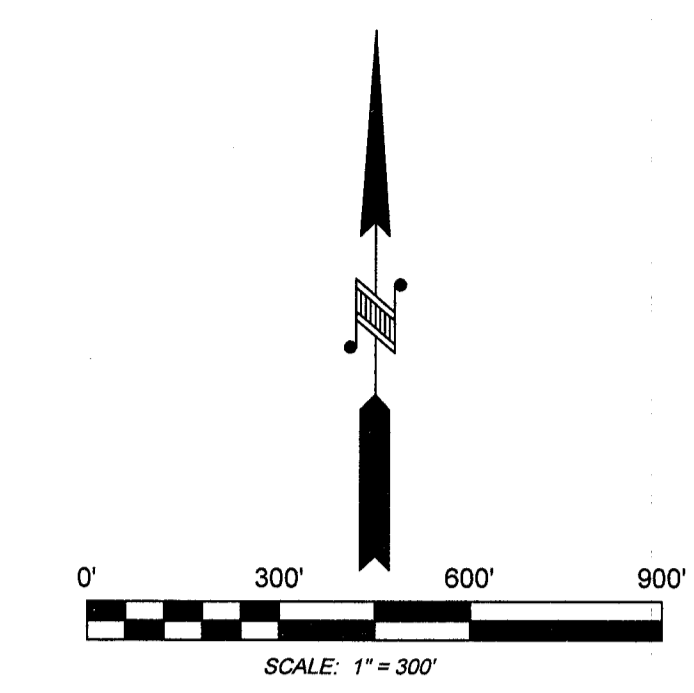

BASIS OF BEARINGS

BEARINGS BASED UPON THE GEODETIC MERIDIAN OBTAINED THROUGH GPS OBSERVATIONS FOR THE PROJECT CONTROL. A LOCAL COORDINATE SYSTEM WAS ESTABLISHED WITH THE ORIGIN BEING THE WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 1. GEODETIC BEARINGS ARE EQUAL TO LOCAL PLANE BEARINGS ON RADIAL LINES EXTENDING FROM THIS ORIGIN.

SURVEYOR'S NOTES

- DISTANCES SHOWN HEREON ARE TO THE TRUE POSITION FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 1 AND NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 2, WHICH IS AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND WAS NEVER SET. THEREFORE, THE FOUND BLM BRASS CAP MARKING THE CLOSING CORNER FOR SECTIONS 1 & 2 IS NOW CONSIDERED AN AUXILIARY MONUMENT TO THE CORNER POSITION.
- FOUND 3 1/4" USFS AC BEARS S07°49'47"W, 3.91' FROM CALCULATED POSITION.
- FOUND 3 1/2" USFS AC BEARS S00°59'04"E, 2.59' FROM CALCULATED POSITION.
- THE CONTRACT FOR THIS SURVEY WAS CANCELED MIDWAY THROUGH THE FIELD WORK. THEREFORE, SHOWN CALCULATED POSITIONS FOR CORNER POSITIONS MAY IN FACT HAVE MONUMENTATION BASED ON PREVIOUS SURVEYS. THE VERIFIED CORNER POSITIONS AND MONUMENTS FOUND HAVE DISTANCES RETURNED AND ARE SHOWN HEREON. FURTHERMORE, THE SECTION BREAKDOWNS SHOWN ON THIS SURVEY ARE BASED ON THE FOUND MONUMENTS AT THE VERIFIED CORNER POSITIONS SHOWN.
- THE PRIMARY PURPOSE FOR THIS SURVEY WAS TO VERIFY POSITIONS OF ALL THE SENIOR CORNERS ALONG THE EXTERIOR TOWNSHIP LINES CONTROLLING THE SECTION BREAKDOWNS FOR SECTIONS 1 & 2, WHICH WERE NOT SHOWN ON PREVIOUS SURVEYS. THIS SURVEY SHOWS THE VERIFIED POSITIONS TO THOSE CORNERS AND SECTION BREAKDOWNS ACCORDINGLY WHICH COINCIDE WITH SOME OF THE PREVIOUS SURVEYS.

1. DISTANCES SHOWN HEREON ARE TO THE TRUE POSITION FOR THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 1 AND NORTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 2, WHICH IS AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE TOWNSHIP LINE AND WAS NEVER SET. THEREFORE, THE FOUND BLM BRASS CAP MARKING THE CLOSING CORNER FOR SECTIONS 1 & 2 IS NOW CONSIDERED AN AUXILIARY MONUMENT TO THE CORNER POSITION.
2. FOUND 3 1/4" USFS AC BEARS S07°49'47"W, 3.91' FROM CALCULATED POSITION.
3. FOUND 3 1/4" USFS AC BEARS S00°59'04"E, 2.59' FROM CALCULATED POSITION.
4. THE CONTRACT FOR THIS SURVEY WAS CANCELED MIDWAY THROUGH THE FIELD WORK. THEREFORE, SHOWN CALCULATED POSITIONS FOR CORNER POSITIONS MAY IN FACT HAVE MONUMENTATION BASED ON PREVIOUS SURVEYS. THE VERIFIED CORNER POSITIONS AND MONUMENTS FOUND HAVE DISTANCES RETURNED AND ARE SHOWN HEREON. FURTHERMORE, THE SECTION BREAKDOWNS SHOWN ON THIS SURVEY ARE BASED ON THE FOUND MONUMENTS AT THE VERIFIED CORNER POSITIONS SHOWN.
5. THE PRIMARY PURPOSE FOR THIS SURVEY WAS TO VERIFY POSITIONS OF ALL THE SENIOR CORNERS ALONG THE EXTERIOR TOWNSHIP LINES CONTROLLING THE SECTION BREAKDOWNS FOR SECTIONS 1 & 2, WHICH WERE NOT SHOWN ON PREVIOUS SURVEYS. THIS SURVEY SHOWS THE VERIFIED POSITIONS TO THOSE CORNERS AND SECTION BREAKDOWNS ACCORDINGLY WHICH COINCIDE WITH SOME OF THE PREVIOUS SURVEYS.
