

**CALL FOR BIDS**  
**Lincoln County Gravel Crushing**

Sealed bids for the crushing and stockpiling of gravel sites within the three road districts in Lincoln County as determined by the Board of County Commissioners, will be received up to and including 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 2, 2022, at the office of said Board in Libby, Montana. Bidders may bid for crushing in all three locations or may bid individual locations only.

The work contemplated consists of crushing and stock-piling gravel in each road district over a twelve-month period as needed from July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027. No minimum amount of crushing is guaranteed. Past performance and ability to accurately verify delivery amounts will be two of the criteria used in the bid award.

By submitting a bid, the bidder guarantees that the equipment necessary to fulfill the terms of this contract is immediately available to begin work at the discretion of the Board of Commissioners. No taxes assessed against the equipment shall be delinquent.
