02:45 PM **Probation/Drop-In-Center Budget Meeting:** Present were Alisha Burrows and Jay Sheffield.

Alisha Burrows and Jay Sheffield presented the Probation budget and noted that the only changes for FY 2026-27 were increases to wages and benefits. All other budget line items remained unchanged. The Drop-In Center budget was also reviewed. Discussion focused on grant funding, personnel costs and grant management fees. Questions regarding grant allocations and indirect costs will be clarified with the granting agency and county finance before any further budget adjustments are made.

03:03 PM **Victim Witness Budget Meeting:** Present was Kathleen Sheffield.

Kathleen Sheffield, Victim Witness Advocate, presented her proposed budget for the upcoming two-year grant cycle. Discussion focused on anticipated grant funding of approximately \$197,000 over two years (about \$97,000 annually) and potential funding shortfalls for expenses not covered by the grant. She will work with county finance to verify budget line items, funding sources and account coding.
