A Resolution Approving Lease of Front-Load Compactor Trucks

THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR LINCOLN COUNTY, MONTANA FINDS:

WHEREAS, Lincoln County, Montana ("County") has determined that the acquisition of front-load compactor trucks is necessary for the continued operation and delivery of essential County services; and

WHEREAS, the County has determined that financing the acquisition of front-load compactor trucks through a Master Lease Purchase Agreement with Lease Servicing Center, Inc. dba NCL Government Capital ("Lessor") is in the best interests of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is authorized under the laws of the State of Montana to enter into lease-purchase agreements for equipment necessary for County operations; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the proposed Master Lease Purchase Agreement and related financing documents and finds that execution of such documents serves a valid public purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Lincoln County, Montana, as follows:

1. The Board approves the execution of the Master Lease Purchase Agreement and related documents with Lease Servicing Center, Inc. dba NCL Government Capital for the lease of front-load compactor trucks.
2. The Chair of the Board and such other County officials as necessary are authorized to execute all documents required to complete the transaction.
3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.



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THE BOARD FURTHER RESOLVES:

1. If a provision of this resolution conflicts with a prior resolution, the provisions of this resolution will control.
2. The provisions of this resolution are severable. If any part is held invalid, the remainder remains in effect.
3. Under Montana Code Annotated § 7-5-123, resolutions are immediately effective unless a delayed date is specified.
4. This resolution must be entered into the minutes and signed by the presiding officer pursuant to § 7-5-121, MCA.
